
How to disable Microsoft Edge as default PDF reader


In order to disable Microsoft Edge's PDF feature, you need to change the $\underline{\text{file}}$ association, which you can do with the following steps:

Using the Settings app


- 1. Click Start button
- 2. Open Settings.
- Click on Apps.
- 4. Click on **Default apps**.
 - Note: If you're still running the Windows 10 Anniversary Update, the path is Settings > System > Default apps.
- 5. Click the Choose default apps by file type link.



- Scroll down and find .pdf (PDF File) on left, and click the button on the right side, which is likely to read "Microsoft Edge."
- 7. Select your app from the list to set it as the new default.



8. Click the **Switch anyway** link to confirm the change.



Once you completed the steps, Microsoft Edge will no longer open PDF files by default in the web browser.
