











The Windows to Work Program is a voluntary re-entry program designed to help individuals transition from incarceration back to the community successfully.

We provide pre- and post-release services while promoting selfsufficiency through skill development and cognitive behavioral training.

Pre- and Post-Release Services May Include:

- Education Planning
- Employment Preparation
 - Resume Development, Job Applications, Interviewing
- Job Search & Placement Assistance
- Financial Literacy Education & Planning
- Supportive Service Assistance
 Transportation, Education, & Work Supplies
- Connections to Workforce Center Services & Community Resources

ELIGIBILITY

- Assessed by P.O. with COMPAS recommended supervision level of medium, medium with override consideration, or high
- On DCC supervision for at least 1 year from enrollment date
- Unemployed at the time of enrollment
- Must be able to work (not collecting or applying for SSI)
- Priority given to those being released to Waukesha, Ozaukee or Washington County
