Our **SUMMER WORK EXPERIENCE PROGRAM** gives you the opportunity to get an overview of a certain field or company, develop your knowledge and skills, gain insight into a certain role and a valuable set of contacts for the future.

HOW DOES THE SUMMER WORK EXPERIENCE PROGRAM WORK?

- You must be between the ages **16 and 21**
- You must be **available to start** a job in June and end in August (*flexible schedule is on a case-by-case basis*)
- You must **attend** and **complete** an orientation and training sessions (see dates on right column)
- You must be willing to work a **minimum of 15 hours a week** up to 240 hours or 90 days, whichever comes first
- Earn **\$10.00 per hour** while learning on the job
