









Our **SUMMER TECHHIRE INTERNSHIP PROGRAM** is designed to help eligible businesses build a talent pipeline by hiring interns during the summer period and providing them with real hand-on work experience in technology related careers. **Hiring businesses can save up to \$3,840 per intern.**

PROGRAM DETAILS

- Program runs from June 17 through August 30, 2019
- Participants are between the ages of 17 and 29 and meet program eligibility criteria
- Participants may work 10 to 40 hours per week for a maximum of 240 hours
- Participants will be on the work site's (hiring company) payroll and paid a minimum hourly rate of \$16.00
- Eligible businesses are in the advanced manufacturing, broad band/finance/information technology, and healthcare industries
- Eligible businesses will help participants gain hand-on experience and learn workplace competencies along their career paths
- Upon successful completion of internship, businesses will be reimbursed for the program participant's wages up to a maximum of 240 hours
